Polystyrene:

- 1. polystyrene primer
- 2. INRAL Décor Hammer paint

Note: Please check the compatibility of plastic surfaces. All other surfaces, such as e.g. stone, clay, ceramics, glass, rattan/bast, card/paper need to be primed with primer/ground. The surface to be painted must be clean, dry and free of grease. Do not spray onto synthetic resin coated surfaces because the paint may lift.
